Bad Worry Troubled about basic needs

THE PROMISED RESULT

 And the peace of God will guard your hearts and minds (which surpasses all understanding) in Christ Jesus. "It is simple... trust in Christ – that in Him God will do everything necessary so that we can enjoy making much of Him forever.
